E. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC FOR ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA

There were no comments from the public for items not on the agenda.

F. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. June 8, 2022, Regular Board Meeting & Public Hearing

Ms. Nguyen presented the minutes of the June 8, 2022, Regular Board Meeting and Public Hearing and asked if there were any changes.

Ms. Nguyen informed the Board that all Supervisors had filed their Statement of Financial Interests 2021 Form 1 in a timely manner.

2. General Election Candidates (Seats 1 & 2; General Election 11/8/22)

Ms. Nguyen reminded the Board that there were two (2) seats up for election this year. Ms. Nguyen stated that Mr. De Cardenas was elected unopposed to his seat (Seat 1) and Ms. Arcelus was also elected unopposed to her seat (Seat 2). Ms. Nguyen further explained that the terms of office for Mr. De Cardenas and Ms. Arcelus would commence on the second Tuesday following the general election (November 22, 2022).

J. BOARD MEMBER & STAFF CLOSING COMMENTS

Ms. Nguyen stated that unless an emergency were to arise, the next Board Meeting would be held in 2023. There were no comments from Board Members.

Dear Ms. Nguyen:

This firm's current fee structure has been in place since 2011. Although we are certainly mindful of the necessity to keep increases in the District's expenses, including the cost of legal services, to a minimum, it has become necessary for us to adjust our hourly rates effective, April 1, 2023 as follows:

Attorneys/Partners: \$275.00 per hour
 Attorneys/Associates: \$225.00 per hour

This hourly fee structure will be adjusted on a periodic basis in connection with the District's budget process no later than every third Fiscal Year to reflect changes in the Consumer Price Index published by the U. S. Department of Labor. The CPI has reflected a 32.4% increase since the year 2011 and we have not raised our fees during that time.
